Song structure

There are 3 parts of the songs. There chord progressions are as follows:

- (1) **Intro:** Am . . . A . . .
- (2) **Main part:** Am . . . Em . . . G . . . Am . . . (repeat)
- (3) **Refrain / ending:** F . C . Dm . Am . F . . G Am . . . (repeat)

Intro riff

The distinctive opening bars of the song can be approximated on guitar as follows:
